The Benton Soil & Water Conservation District will be holding its Third annual conservation coloring contest. This year's theme is "Our Soil—A Layer of Life." There will be three groups for Benton County students:

Group A—Kindergarten

Group B—1st & 2nd grades

Group C—3rd & 4th grades

Guidelines:

- Students must color the sheet provided (do not enlarge or downsize picture)
- Only **WAX** crayons may be used
- There can only be one entry per student
- All entries must have the following information on the back of the coloring sheet:
 1. Name of student
 2. Parents Names
 3. Student's Address
 4. Name of School, Grade
 5. Name of Teacher

Judging/Awards:

- Color pages will be judged on creativity, neatness, and attention to detail
- A first, second, and third place winner will be selected from each group
 - First place** winners will receive **\$15.00** and an award certificate
 - Second place** winners will receive **\$10.00** and an award certificate
 - Third place** winners will receive **\$5.00** and an award certificate

In addition to the winning students receiving their prize, the 1st place winners in Group A, B, and C will also win \$50.00 to be rewarded to their teacher as a classroom award!
