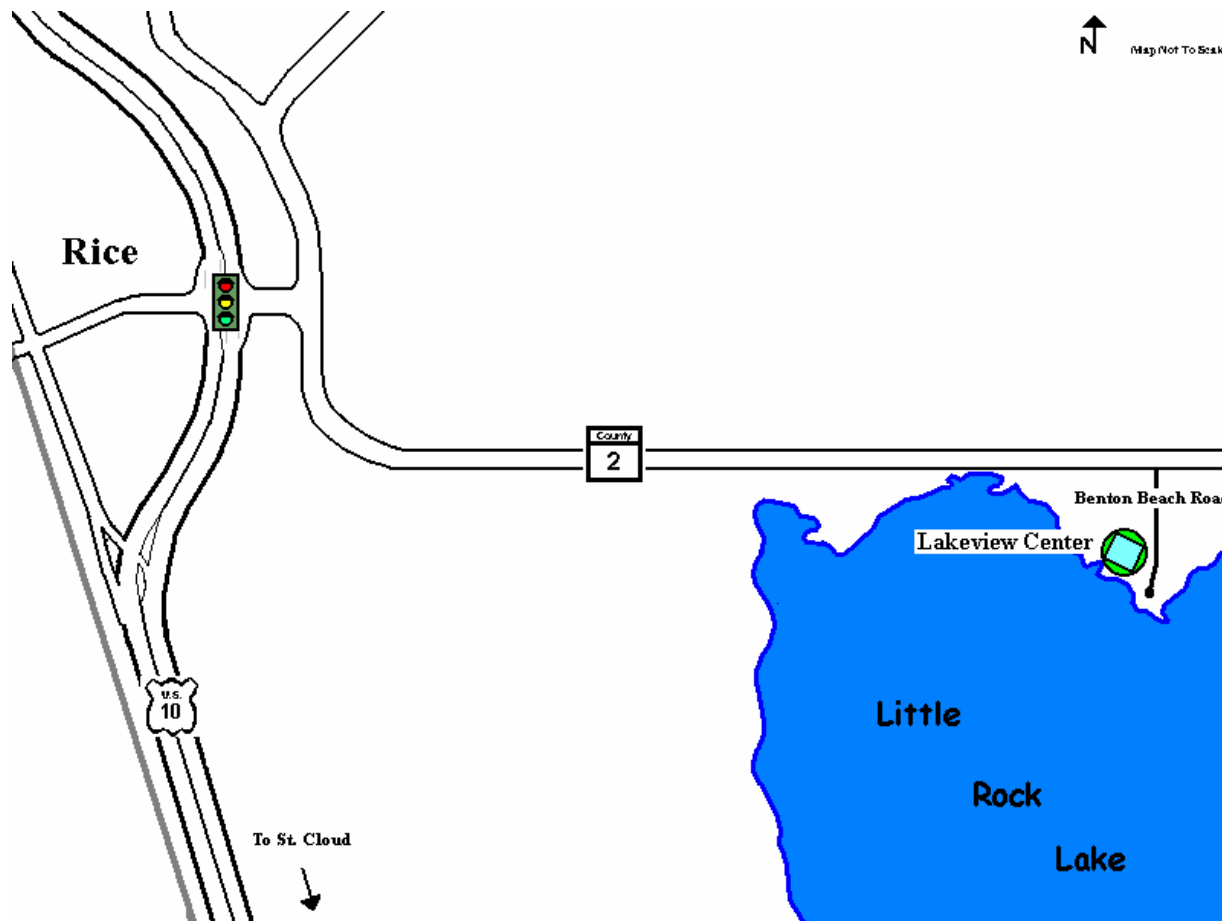

From the East: Take State Hwy 25 north/north west. Turn left onto CR 2/125th St NE and follow for 3.5 miles. Lake View Center will be on the south side of the road, follow the Benton Beach Park road to the building.
